Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: Are we returning to school this year?

A: No, the Governor has mandated the rest of the school year to be completed through a distance learning format. Distance Learning for the Adult Schools will begin April 20th, 2020. You will be contacted by your teacher.

Q: Am I still graduating?

A: High School Diploma students will receive proof of graduation once you complete your last credit.

Q: I don't have access to the internet; what do I do?

A: ► Spectrum is offering free internet to households that do not have internet. 1-844-488-8395. Reduced internet to current users through their internet essentials program. To apply call (English) 1-855-846-8376 and (Spanish) 1-855-765-6995 or apply online www.internetessentials.com. Once you qualify for the internet essentials program you can apply for a low cost computer.

Q: When will I be contacted by my teachers?

A: Teachers have started contacting students, if you don't hear from your teacher, let us know.

Q: Am I still able to get one on one help from my teacher?

A: Teachers will be emailing, conducting video conferences and doing group video instruction.

Q: When will the school be open for classes at the school site?

A: No one knows yet. We are following the CDC and state guidelines.

Q: How and when can I register for next school year?

A: To be determined. A system will be put in place depending on the circumstances.

Q: Is GED/HiSET testing available?

A: The GED/HiSET official tests have been suspended. GED/HiSET students can continue to prepare for the tests through our distance learning classes. Once testing resumes, students will be notified. We are planning a virtual graduation for GED/HiSET and High School Diploma graduates. More information will be shared soon.
